Aquatics facility in the Biosciences Building. While pressure washing a tank in room 1248, my hand accidently got in the way of the jet stream and I sustained a small break in the skin which bled, and I am now concerned that foreign material may have been introduced to my blood stream

Describe fully what happened before, during, and after the incident (please do not include personal information such as names, gender pronouns and medical information):

While holding the pressure nozzle in the on position in my right hand, I was using my left had to move a pH probe out of the way when I accidently hit my left thumb with the jet stream from the nozzle of the pressure washer. I sustained a 0.5cm break in the skin on my left thumb which bled and now I am concerned that foreign material may have been introduced to my blood stream. The water source came from a tap that dispenses dechlorinated water. I was wearing thick pants, steel toe work boots, thick pants, t-shirt, eye protection, hearing protection *But I was not wearing gloves* The technique I was using to get the pH probe out of the way was unsafe and was a contributing factor also.
